

## Shrinky Dink Keychains

### Supplies Needed:

- Shrinky Dink paper (provided by the library)
- Pencil for drawing/tracing
- Picture for tracing (the library will provide some, or you can print out and trace or draw whatever you want!)
- Colored pencils, markers (regular or permanent) for coloring
- Scissors to cut out picture
- Hole punch
- Keychain (provided by the library)
- Thin cookie sheet covered with aluminum foil or parchment paper
- Oven

### Instructions:

- 1.) Trace or draw your pictures onto the Shrinky Dink paper. If you are using the keychain provided by the library, there are rings attached to your keychain to add up to three objects! Each one will turn out about 1/3 the size of your original picture.
- 2.) Color your pictures on the ROUGH side of the paper, using colored pencils, markers, or permanent markers. Your colors will become more intense as the object shrinks.
- 3.) Punch a hole at the top of each object for the keychain.
- 4.) Place your objects on a thin cookie sheet (not the insulated kind), covered with parchment paper or aluminum foil and bake at 350 degrees for 1-2 minutes. All ovens are different, so watch closely! You will see the object curl up and flatten back out. Once it flattens, wait about 30 seconds, and it's done!
- 5.) Carefully take your Shrinky Dink(s) out of the oven and let them cool before attaching to the key chain!
